## I fixed the motors in my mirror (87 Spider)

My remote mirror motors did not function. I heard some noise, but the mirrors did not move at all. As I had to disassembly the mirrors for painting anyway, I tried to fix the motors.

## Step A) SEE PICTURES

The front cover (usually painted in the body colour is a pressure fix. Take a long thin flat screwdriver and push the cover off. (pushing from in-between the housing and the mirror). Make sure to hold the mirror frame, you do not want to brake it off!!







Step B) SEE PICTURES Once the cover is off you can gently pry-off the mirror. The actual mirror is attached with 4 plastic snaps.



Step C) SEE PICTURES

I sprayed a fair amount of BLASTER into the mirror mechanism (make sure the stuff does not drip on your paint).

A lot of grime, rust and dirt started dripping out of the mechanism. I rocked the mirror switch back and forth in all directions.



VOILA suddenly the mirror started working !!!!
